

DNR “Off-highway Vehicle System Plan(s)” to develop scramble area and interconnecting trails for all-terrain vehicles, dirt-bike motorcycles, and four-wheel drive trucks in Minnesota’s forests, parks, and adjacent to the Superior Hiking Trail and Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness

The gas-tax funded grant-in-aid program has also funded Trails and Waterways planning of off-highway vehicle trails and scramble areas through wetlands and other sensitive areas. Following is a photograph of just one trail proposed in South St. Louis County that traverses an active beaver pond.
